

データベースは、わが国の情報化の進展上、重要な役割を果たすものと期待されている。今後、データベースの普及により、わが国において健全な高度情報化社会の形成が期待される。さらに海外に対して提供可能なデータベースの整備は、国際的な情報化への貢献および自由な情報流通の確保の観点からも必要である。しかしながら、現在わが国で流通しているデータベースの中でわが国独自のものは1/3にすぎないのが現状であり、わが国データベースサービスひいてはバランスある情報産業の健全な発展を図るためには、わが国独自のデータベースの構築およびデータベース関連技術の研究開発を強力に促進し、データベースの拡充を図る必要がある。

このような要請に応えるため、(財) データベース振興センターでは日本自転車振興会から機械 工業振興資金の交付を受けて、データベースの構築および技術開発について民間企業、団体等に対 して委託事業を実施している。委託事業の内容は、社会的、経済的、国際的に重要で、また地域お よび産業の発展の促進に寄与すると考えられているデータベースの構築とデータベース作成の効率 化、流通の促進、利用の円滑化・容易化などに関係したソフトウェア技術・ハードウェア技術であ る。

本事業の推進に当って、当財団に学識経験者の方々で構成されるデータベース構築・技術開発促 進委員会(委員長 山梨学院大学教授 蓼沼良一氏)を設置している。

この「マーケティングコードの英文データベースの構築」は平成4年度のデータベースの構築促進および技術開発促進事業として、当財団が(株)帝国データバンクに対して委託実施した課題の一つである。この成果が、データベースに興味をお持ちの方々や諸分野の皆様方のお役に立てば幸いである。

なお、平成4年度データベースの構築促進および技術開発促進事業で実施した課題は次表のとおりである。

1. 日本産業分類と帝国産業分類

産業分類を定義するメリットは次のとおりである。

- ① 企業の経済活動を簡潔に表現する。
- ② 同様の産業に分類される企業をデータベースより抽出し、比較・分析する。
- ③ 産業に関する分析を行い、統計資料を作成する。

こうした産業分類が、世にいくつも存在することは望ましくない。

しかも、その分類が比較・分析の目的に見合って適度に細分化されたものであること、時系列で の分析を行うために安定したものであること、普遍性をもったものであることなどの条件をみたす 必要がある。

統計資料を作成する場合、各人が全く異なる定義のもとに設定された産業分類を使用すると、それぞれの資料を比較・分析することが非常に困難になるばかりではなく、統計資料自体の普遍性が失われ、なんの価値も意義も見いだせないことにもなりかねない。

これらを考慮して、帝国データバンクでは、総務庁(旧行政管理庁)の日本標準産業分類をスタンダードコードとし、これに商用データベースとして活用するためのノウハウを付加した帝国産業分類(TEIKOKU DATABANK INDUSTRIAL CODE:以下TIC)を設定した。

このTICは、日本標準産業分類を母体に、永年にわたり多業種におよぶ企業の経営状態について調査活動を行ってきた帝国データバンクの業種分類ノウハウを加味したもので、1956年5月に完成、運用が開始された。

その後、企業情報のデータベース化による業種分類ニーズの多様化に伴い、1975年10月までに4次にわたる部分改訂を行い、現在に至っている。

2. TICの特色および体系

2.1 TICの特色

TICは、企業の経済活動に関するフルレポートである[信用調査報告書]、企業財務に関するデータベース[COSMOS1]、企業の概要に関するデータベース[COSMOS2]、企業の倒産件数の集計や産業ごとの景気動向指標などの統計資料になど、帝国データバンクの保有する企業情報のあちゆる分野で使用されている。

例えば、[COSMOS 2]では、主業、従業として1企業に対して最大2つのTICが付加されている。その結果、企業のセールスランキング(同じ分類の中で売り上げが何位に位置しているか)の提供や『東京都港区にある情報サービス業を営む企業』あてのダイレクトメール用のアドレスタッグの出力等、さまざまな活用が可能となっている。

2.2 TICの体系

TICは、大分類/中分類/小分類の3段階分類から成り立っている。

大分類は 14項目 アルファベット [A] ~ [N]

[例] A 農業

中分類は 90項目 アラビア数字 2ケタ [01]~[99]

[例] 12 原油、天然ガス鉱業

小分類は 673項目 アラビア数字 3ケタから5ケタ

[例] 1 2 1 原油鉱業

3 2 1 - 3 ガラス容器製造業

409-21 石油卸売業

3. 帝国データバンクマーケティングコード作成の意義

産業の進展で、ニューサービスや新業態の増加にともなう分類体系自体に対する見直しの声や、 企業のきめ細かいマーケティング戦略導入により、TICのマイナーチェンジでは対応しきれない、 さらなる業種の細分化が望まればじめた。

帝国データバンクでは、TICの細分化要望に応え、新しい産業分類体系 [マーケティングコード TMC]を設定した。TMCは、ニューサービスや新業態の積極的な収録により、様々に変化を遂げる産業形態をできる限り包含した体系となっている。TMCの特色は次のとおりである。

① 現状の産業情勢に則している。

存在する業種、サービスの一つひとつをコード化することは可能である。しかし、コードが膨大で多岐にわたることにより、運用に支障をきたしてはいけない。例えばニューサービスを新たにコード化するにあたっても、現状の市場規模および将来性を材料としてコード化を判断、やみくもな設定は避けている。現実に衰えつつある産業、わが国でも数が少ない産業については独立した分類とせず、[その他大勢] 分類ともいうべきバスケット項目を作成し、今後の情勢の変化に応じてコード化を判断する方針とした。

② 実用的でマーケティングニーズに合致している。

マーケティングコードは、標準産業分類、TICの小分類はもとより、営業部門で収集する業種によるデータベース抽出条件ニーズなどを、様々な角度から検証し、活発に活動している業種、サービスを中心に収録している。

また、訪問販売、通信販売といった特定の業態も取り入れたコード設定をしており、マーケティングニーズを考慮した実用的なものである。

③ 実際の運用のし易さを重視したコードである。

設定したコードを実際に運用する際の最大のポイントは、コード探しの容易さである。たとえば、 帝国データバンクが保有している企業データベースへのコーディングやそのメンテナンス作業が効率よくできるかどうかが生産性に大きく関わっている。そのためにはコードが適当な数であること、コードの名称が具体的でわかりやすいものであることが必要である。コード名称は、実際の弊社の調査資料や一般的表現を参考にしつつ設定している。また、言いまわしや表現を換えたものも、類語として収録し、なるべく検索に個人差がでないように配慮した。

④ TIC小分類に則している。

TICが、帝国データバンク社員のみならず多くのユーザーに企業情報データベースを通じて親

しまれていることに着目し、その小分類673項目を利用してマーケティングコードを設定した。 5桁で構成されているTIC小分類に枝番2桁を付加し、7桁としている。これにより小分類の細分化が99まで可能となった。

⑤ 業態での抽出が可能である。

TICでは表現できなかった量販店、訪問販売、通信販売、賃加工等の一部「業態」にも小分類に沿ってマーケティングコードを設定し、抽出可能となっている。

下2ケタ 60~65自動販売機による販売

67~69賃加工

70~79訪問販売

80~89通信販売

90~98量販店

4. TMCの構成

マーケティングコードは、

- 1) マーケティングコードおよび名称
- 2) マーケティングコードに対応するTIC
- 3) マーケティングコード名称を他の表現で言い替えた類語 より構成されている。

① マーケティングコード

マーケティングコードはTIC《5桁》に枝番《2桁》を付加した《7桁》で構成されている。 総設定数は3,162である。

【例】 [ハウスクリーニング業 864-00-06] は、建物サービス業 864-00 (TIC) に《2桁》06を付加したもの。

② 類語について

マーケティングコード名称を言い替えたものである。例えば、電化製品卸、電気製品卸、家庭電 化製品卸は類語であり、どの言葉からでもマーケティングコードに行き当るように設定されている。

5. 英文化の背景

1989年12月8日付け日本経済新聞に次の記事が掲載された。

「通産省は輸入拡大対策の一環として今年度中に、全国の消費者や流通業者に輸入関連情報を届ける「草の根国際化センター情報ネットワーク」をつくる方針を固めた。

米国の輸出希望企業などを検索できる米商務省の情報ネットワークと接続し、輸入拡大に役立てる。日米貿易不均衡の解消に向けた日米共同プログラムの具体化第一弾となる。 自民党経済調整特別調査会も7日に発表した提言に同様の考え方を盛り込んでおり、通産省はこの構想を核とする輸入拡大対策費として、今年度の補正予算に75億円を計上するよう働きかけていく。…… (略) ……新たにつくる情報ネットワークは東京・虎ノ門の日本貿易振興会(ジェトロ)本部にホストコンピュータを置き、…… (略) ……ホストコンピュータには輸入品や輸入企業、海外の対日輸出希望企業などに関する情報を蓄積し、地方の中小流通業者や消費者が情報を検索できるようにする。個人輸入を支援する情報や輸入品のアフタケアに関する情報も提供する。

米商務省も輸出品目やその価格、輸出希望企業などを検索できる情報ネットワークをすでに持っているので、日本の情報網と接続して検索できる情報量に厚みを加える。……(略)……「情報面から閉鎖的取引慣行などに風穴をあけたい」としている。……(略)……」(日本経済新聞より原文どおり一部抜粋)

この記事を背景に弊社では、企業情報データベース・COSMOS 2 の和文・英文データベースを活用するようジェトロに対し提案した。

ジェトロではアンケート方式で輸入取引関心企業・輸入取引関心商品のデータベース化に着手していた。

ジェトロの構想は海外のバイヤーが輸出したい商品で検索し、日本側で同商品を取り扱っている 業者を抽出できるデータベースの構築であった。

弊社の提案に対しては関心を示しながらも次の点が問題となった。(弊社では帝国産業分類「日本標準産業分類に準拠」を使用)

- ① ジェトロの構想では単品で検索出来ることが前提である。
- ② 産業分類は統計向きで分類が荒く、構想外である。
- ③ 商品分類はHSコード(88年から国際的に採用された新しい関税分類コード)が望ましい。 などが焦点になった。

弊社では、HSコード (国際関税コード)、SICコード (Standard Industrial Classification Manual) に関して研究を続けていたが、ともに日本の商品コードとしては日本特有の商品に対応できず、独自のコード付けを余儀なくされるなど、いずれのコードを採用しても体系の維持は難しく実情に合わず、現データベースで使用している産業分類との整合性からも両コードの採用を見送った。

6. 英文化の目的

海外から日本企業の情報に関心が高いとのことで、ダイアログ(DIALOG Information Services, Inc.)から熱心な勧めがあったほか、海外および国内のディストリビュータからも英文COSMOS2の海外提供について多くのアプローチがあった。

当社ではデータベースの国際流通の側面から、1991年4月からダイアログをディストリビュータとして日本企業COSMOS2の英文版5万社(現在は18万社)のサービスを開始した。 次いで国内においても、日経テレコン、ジーサーチをディストリビュータとしてサービスを開始した。 た。

前述のとおり、初期の利用は単に日本の企業情報を知りたいとするニーズからエンドユーザーが 輸出したい商品(希望する商品名で検索)を扱うパートナーを探したいとするニーズは拡大、多様 化されつつある。

これらのニーズに応えるには言葉の問題を解決することが先決になるが、現状ではニーズに応えられる既存の体系も手段もなく、独自に英文化することは避けられない。

しかし、ニーズのサイズも把握できない状況では費用対効果が最大のネックであることが議論の 対象になったが、我が国から海外向けに日本企業の情報を英文で提供しているのが当社のみである ことから、これらの国際的ニーズに応えることは避けて通れないとの結論を得た。

極言すれば、現在のダイアログおよび国内のディストリビュータを通じてのサービスが初期の日本企業の情報を知る手段としての利用に加えて、マーケティングコードをキーにした検索は単にサービス内容の拡大に留まらず、日米貿易摩擦解消の一助にもなるものと考えたからでもある。

この様な背景を踏まえてマーケティングコードの英文化とデータベースの構築を通じてコードマスタの整備に着手した。

7. SIC対応の意義

課題応募時においては単にマーケティングコードを英文化するとの発想であった。

企画段階における検討ではHS(関税分類コード)、SIC(Standard Industrial Classification Manual)の対応も考慮した。しかし、日本標準産業分類がベースになっている関係から、我国特有の商品などの対応に問題が多く、本課題が完成した後に再度、検討することで保留にした。

本課題が採択され、委託契約締結後の最初の取り組みとしてマーケティングコード英文化に向けての基礎調査を行うこととした。

基礎調査はサーチャーとして実績を持つ(株)エポックリサーチに委託することにした。

委託テーマはマーケティングコードを海外のエンドユーザーが使用可能な英文翻訳と利用しやす い体系の整備を主目的とした。

本調査報告書は別添のとおりであるが、主旨は次のとおりである。

- ・ダイアログの企業データベースにおける標準産業分類の採択状況
 - ① ダイアログで提供されている企業データベースのうち、米国企業データベースの大部分 (92%)では、米国SICコードもしくはこれを細分化したものを採用している。
 - ② ダイアログで提供されている企業データベースのうち、米国以外の企業データベースでは、米国SICコードを採用しているものが38%、自国SICコードのみが16% (英国、日本)、KOMPASSコード (UCS準拠)を採用しているものが22%である。
 - ③ 以上の結果から、米国のユーザーを念頭において産業分類コードを付けるのならば米 国SICコードを付与することが望ましい。
 - ④ マーケティングコード英訳作業と並行してSICコードへの変換作業を行う可能性を 検討すべきである。
- ・マーケティングコードの英文化および米国SICコードの比較
 - ① 対応する分野の米国SICコードを日本語に訳す。
 - ② マーケティングコードを英文化するにあたり、該当する訳語があればそれを採用し、 末尾に対応する米国SICコードを付加。
 - ③ マーケティングコードに該当する米国SICがなければ、独自の訳語を作成。


なお、ヒアリング時にダイアログの海外での利用が日欧各50%であるとの報告もあり、同報告書を受けて社内プロジェクトで検討した。

検討の結果

- ① 英文化の主旨が国際的ニーズに応え、データベースの国際流通を促進することが基本であること。
- ② 企画段階で検討のとおり、国際的に流通する米国SICとの対応が可能であれば対応 可能分のみでも促進した方がよいこと。
- ③ マーケティングコードの英文化が主体であるが、米国SICと対応出来た分は米国SICをキーにしたマーケティングコードとの対応表も作成すること。

以上の結論を持って、当初企画した中で最も使用頻度の高い米国SICとの対応を付けることにした。

8. 英文マーケティングコードの展望と課題

帝国データバンクでは、海外からの日本企業に関する情報についてのニーズが一段と高まりつつ あることから、ダイアログ社との提携により1991年4月より英文COSMOS2(企業情報 ファイル)の提供を開始した。

ボーダレス化により、地球規模で各種の流通が活発化している環境下において、相手を知り、その安全性を確保することの重要性は大きく、国境を越えての必須課題であるとの判断に立ち、国際的ニーズに応えることにした。

しかし、海外に情報を提供する場合に常に問題となるのが言葉であり、少なくとも国際共通語である英文化はリスクを負いつつも避けて通れない課題であった。

これらのリスクを少しでも解消し、利用を促進するには現地で、よりきめ細かいサービスを展開することが必要であることから、米国における窓口として、1992年4月現地法人 TEIKOKU DATABANK AMERICA, INC を設立した。

日本の企業情報を海外へ提供する業務は、国際的規模で展開される取り引きの円滑を側面から支える社会的任務であり、社会的使命と位置づけることができる。

現実には、一旦サービスを開始するとユーザーのニーズはさらに拡大し、現サービスの産業分類 コードによる検索機能に対し、商品単位での検索が可能な新しいサービス機能を求められ、この対 応も費用対効果の面からIP (Information Provider) に新たな課題を負うことになっていた。

8.1 展望

マーケティングコードの英文化は

- ① ユーザーのニーズに応える。
- ② 新しいユーザーの創造、ビジネスチャンスの拡大。
- ③ データベースの利用拡大など。

大いに期待が持てる。

特に海外で広く利用されている米国SICとマーケティングコードとの対応はユーザーが使い慣れたコードからの検索を可能にし、利用範囲が格段に拡大されるものと期待される。極言すれば輸出入の促進の一助になることも期待できる。

8.2 課 題

データベースの最大の課題はデータのメンテナンスにあり、マーケティングコードについても同様な課題がある。

- 1) メンテナンス
 - ① 新しい商品の収録とコード付け。
- ② 英文翻訳。
 - ③ SICとの対応。
- 2) データ管理
 - ① 新しいコードの付加作業。
 - ② 的確な収録と鮮度、正確性の維持。

1. 調査結果

- 1.1 DIALOGの企業データベースにおける標準産業分類の採用状況 (表1参照)
 - ①DIALOGで提供されている企業データベースのうち、米国企業データベースの大部分 (92%) では、米国SICコードもしくはこれを細分化したものを採用している。
 - ②DIALOGで提供されている企業データベースのうち、米国以外の企業データベースでは、米国SICコードを採用しているものが38%、自国SICコードのみを採用しているものが16%(英国・日本)、KOMPASSコード(UCS準拠)を採用しているものが22%である。
 - ③以上の結果から、米国のユーザーを念頭において産業分類コードを付けるのならば、 米国SICコードを付与することが望ましい。
 - ④TMC英訳作業と並行してSICコードへの変換作業を行う可能性を検討すべきである。

1.3 作業結果の検討

DIVISION B

Mining

The Division as a Whole

This division includes all establishments primarily engaged in mining. The term mining is used in the broad sense to include the extraction of minerals occurring naturally: solids, such as coal and ores; liquids, such as crude petroleum; and gases such as natural gas. The term mining is also used in the broad sense to include quarrying, well operations, milling (e.g., crushing, screening, washing, flotation), and other preparation customarily done at the mine site, or as a part of mining activity.

Exploration and development of mineral properties are included. Services performed on a contract or fee basis in the development or operation of mineral properties are classified separately but within this division. Establishments which have complete responsibility for operating mines, quarries, or oil and gas wells for others on a contract or fee basis are classified according to the product mined rather than as mineral services.

Mining operations are classified, by industry, on the basis of the principal mineral produced, or, if there is no production, on the basis of the principal mineral for which exploration or development work is in process. The mining of culm banks, ore dumps, and tailing piles is classified as mining according to the principal mineral product derived.

The purification and distribution of water is classified in Transportation and Public Utilities, Industry 4941, and the bottling and distribution of natural spring and mineral waters is classified in Wholesale Trade, Industry 5149.

Crushing, grinding, or otherwise preparing clay, ceramic, and refractory minerals; barite; and miscellaneous nonmetallic minerals, except fuels, not in conjunction with mining or quarrying operations, are classified in Manufacturing, Industry 3295. Dressing of stone or slabs is classified in Manufacturing, Industry 3281, whether or not mining is done at the same establishment.

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in mining, developing mines, or exploring for metallic minerals (ores). These ores are valued chiefly for the metals contained, to be recovered for use as such or as constituents of alloys, chemicals, pigments or other products. This major group also includes all ore dressing and beneficiating operations, whether performed at mills operated in conjunction with the mines served or at mills, such as custom mills, operated separately. These include mills which crush, grind, wash, dry, sinter, calcine, or leach ore, or perform gravity separation or flotation operations. Magnesite and brucite operations are classified in Industry 1459, and crushed dolomite operations are classified in Industry 1422. Smelters and refineries are classified in Manufacturing, Major Group 33, and establishments engaged in producing primary magnesium metal are classified in Manufacturing, Industry 3339. The operation of brine wells or sea water plants for the production of magnesium is classified in Manufacturing, Major Group 28.

When performed by operators of the properties, exploration under preliminary phases of operation should be classified according to the type of ore expected to be found. Exploration performed on a contract or fee basis is classified in Industry 1981.

DIVISION C

Construction

The Division as a Whole


This division includes establishments primarily engaged in construction. The term construction includes new work, additions, alterations, reconstruction, installations, and repairs. Construction activities are generally administered or managed from a relatively fixed place of business, but the actual construction work is performed at one or more different sites. If a company has more than one relatively fixed place of business from which it undertakes or manages construction activities and for which separate data on the number of employees, payroll, receipts, and other establishment-type records are maintained, each such place of business is considered a separate construction establishment.

Three broad types of construction activity are covered: (1) building construction by general contractors or by operative builders; (2) heavy construction other than building by general contractors and special trade contractors; and (3) construction activity by other special trade contractors. Special trade contractors are primarily engaged in specialized construction activities, such as plumbing, painting, and electrical work, and work for general contractors under subcontract or directly for property owners. General contractors usually assume responsibility for an entire construction project, but may subcontract to others all of the actual construction work or those portions of the project that require special skills or equipment. General contractors thus may or may not have construction workers on their payroll.

Building construction general contractors are primarily engaged in the construction of dwellings, office buildings, stores, farm buildings, and other building construction projects. Operative builders who build on their own account for resale are also included in this division. However, investment builders who build structures on their own account for rental are classified in Real Estate, Major Group 65, but separate establishments primarily engaged in construction for the investment builder are classified in this division.

General contractors and special trade contractors for heavy construction other than building are primarily engaged in the construction of highways; pipelines, communications and power lines, and sewer and water mains; and other heavy construction projects. Special trade contractors are classified in heavy construction other than building if they are primarily engaged in activities such as grading for highway and airport runways; guardrail construction; installation of highway signs; asphalt and concrete construction of roads, highways, streets and public sidewalks; trenching; cable laying; conduit construction; underwater rock removal; pipeline wrapping; or land clearing and leveling.

A AGRICULTURE

This division includes establishments primarily engaged in agricultural production. livestock feeding (including poultry): sericulture, bee keeping, and related agricultural services, as well as grain and vegetable farms, fields (dry), livestock farms

stock breeding farms, greenhouses, edible fungi farms, bee farms and meadows.

Establishments which perform both agricultural and manufacturing activities are classified according to the following criteria:

- (1) If the manufacturing activities are performed using purchased agricultural products, they are not classified as agricultural establishments.
- (2) If the manufacturing activities are performed using their own agricultural products, they are classified as agricultural establishments. However, those establishments, which operate factories on the same premises as an agricultural site and employ full

-time workers for manufacturing activities, are not classified as agricultural establishments.

Agricultural associations without any specific activities are classified in Industry Group 841 (Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery Cooperative Associations) of Division L (Service Industry), whereas agricultural associations with specific activities a

re classified based on their major activities.

Slaughterers and contracted slaughterers are classified in Industry Group 9 52 (Slaughterhouses).

B FORESTRY AND HUNTING

This division includes establishments primarily engaged in planting of for ests, deforestation, firewood cutting, charcoal making, and gathering of forest products such as natural resin or bark, as well as other forestry-related services.

Establishments primarily engaged in hunting wild animals are also classified in this division

C FISHERIES AND AQUACULTURE

Establishments engaged in fishing are classified based on their fishing grounds, fishingboat type, fishing methods, and kinds of fish products. Establishments engaged in aquaculture are classified based on their form of culture ground, farming or cult

ure methods, and kinds of aquacultural products.

An establishment engaged in more than two industries is classified in which ever industry accounts for a significant share of the total value of sales for the production of its major products. If it is difficult to determine which is the major produc

tion, the establishment may then be classified on the number of full-time workers devoted to activities of the respective industry.

Establishments which perform both fishery (aquaculture) and manufacturing a re-classified according to the following criteria:

- (1) If the manufacturing activities are performed using purchased fishery (aquacultural) products, they are not classified as fishery (aquacultural) establishments
- (2) If the manufacturing activities are performed using their own fishery (aquacultural) products, they are classified as fishery (aquacultural) establishments. However, those establishments which operate factories on the same premises as the fishery (aqua

cultural) site and employ full-time workers for manufacturing activities are not classified as fishery (aquacultural) establishments

Establishments which perform manufacturing activities such as canning fish products in their own fishingboats are regarded as fishery establishments and are classified in this division.

Fishermen's cooperative associations without any specific activities are classified in Industry Group 841 (Agriculture. Forestry and Fishery Cooperative Associations) of Division L (Services), whereas, fishermen's cooperative associations with specifi

c activities are classified

in each corresponding industry.

Establishments primarily engaged in refrigerated warehousing and storage are classified in Industry Group 662 (Refrigerated Warehousing) of Division J (Transport and Communication)

D MINING

This division includes establishments primarily engaged in the production of natural gasoline from natural gas or casing—head gas. Establishments primarily engaged in refining of metallic ores to extract contained metals are classified in industry gro

up 33 (Iron and Steel, and Manufacturing of Non-Ferrous Metals) of Division F (Manufacturing).

Establishments primarily engaged in the production of coke and its by-products from coal are classified in industry group 292 (Coke and Semi-Coke). Establishments engaged in the production of gas from coal and the distribution of it are classified in

industry group 711 (Gas).

Establishments engaged in the distribution of natural gas are classified in industry group 711 (Gas).

Establishments engaged in the refining of crude petroleum are classified in industry group 291 (Petroleum Refining) of division F. (Manufacturing).

Establishments engaged in grinding and pulverizing of stone, or cutting dimension stone are classified in industry group 327 (Aggregate and Stone Products) of division F (Manufacturing).

Establishments engaged in trading of tombstones or stone monuments as well as in the curving and finishing of them are classified in industry group 499-9 (Miscellaneous Retail Trade, Not Elsewhere Classified) or division G (Wholesale and Retail Trade)

Establishments are classified, however, in this division if the carving and finishing work are done at the mine site.

Note:

- (1) Establishments which have complete responsibility for refining of brimstone. or production of stone clay and porcelain clay, while quarrying raw materials by themselves, are classified in this division.
- (2) Establishments engaged in prospecting mines including geological surveys of mine sites and geophysical or chemical exploration of mines, as well as in devel opment of mines such as opening, boring and the removal of slag, spoil, and other debris are cla

ssified in this division.

E CONSTRUCTION

This division includes establishments primarily engaged in construction und er direct management or by contract. Establishments primarily engaged in mainten ance and repair work or in planning, investigating, surveying, designing, and supervising of con

struction are not classified as construction establishments.

Construction is defined as the following activities performed at one or more different sites:

- (1) The constructing, remodeling, repair, demolition, removal, or reconstruction of buildings, structures, and facilities fixed on the land, as well as install ation of attached equipment to these buildings, structures, and facilities.
- (2) The improvement of or preparation of the ground or channels.
- (3) The installation, dismantling, or moving of mechanical equipment.

Establishments primarily engaged in maintenance and repair work are classified based on their main activities.

An establishment engaged in the manufacture or trading of products as well as in construction (other than the installation, demolition, or removal of mechanical equipment) using its own products may be classified based on its main activity.

Establishments primarily engaged in prospecting, drilling, or earth-moving for the mining of metal, non-metal, coal, petroleum or natural gas are classified in one of the major groups 10 through 13 of division D (Mining).

Establishments primarily engaged in leasing, brokerage, the management or a gency of real estate properties (site and buildings), or real estate property subdivision without undertaking construction by themselves are classified in major

group 59 (Real Estate) of division I (Real Estate). Establishments primarily engaged in dri

Establishments primarily engaged in drilling (except for ores), surveying, and design or the supervision of construction are classified in industry group 8 74 (Civil Engineering and Architectural Services) of division L (Service). F MANUFACTURING

Establishments are classified in this division, if they meet the following two criteria:

(1) Establishments which are primarily engaged in manufacturing or processing new products. Establishments primarily engaged in assembling finished parts in order to complete new products are classified in this division, but those engaged in sorting or pac

kaging new products are not classified in this division. Assembly of structures flxed to specific pieces of land, such as buildings, are not classified in this division but in Division E (Construction).

- (2) Establishments which are primarily engaged in selling their new products who lesale as follows:
- a: New products are sold to wholesale or retail dealers.
- b: Large amounts of new products are sold to industrial users including factories, mines, construction industries, agricultural and fishery establishments, business organizations, government and municipal offices, public corporations, schools, hospitals an

d hotels.

c: New products are transferred to factories or sales offices of the same company.

Establishments engaged in the retail trade of their own products are not classified in this division. However, establishments engaged in repairing ships, repairing and remodeling various kinds of railroad cars (other than railroad companies repairing a

nd remodeling their own railroad cars), overhauling aircraft, and the production and repair of various machinery and their parts are classified in this division

Establishments related to Agriculture and Fishery:

(1) If the manufacturing activities are performed using their own agricultural products, they are not classified as manufacturing establishments. However, those establishments, which operate factories on the same site and employ full-time workers for manuf

acturing activities, are classified as manufacturing establishments.

- (2) Those which perform manufacturing activities such as canning fish products in their own fishing boats are not classified as manufacturing establishments.
- (3) Those primarily engaged in charcoal making, sawing of timber at the logging site, or production of crude camphor at the extraction site are not classified as manufacturing establishments.

Establishments related to the Wholesale and Retail Trade

(1) Those involved in such activities as the sorting, preparation, washing or packaging of agricultural products for trade are not classified as manufacturing establishments. However if the establishments are engaged in the wholesale of milk as well as the

sterilizing and bottling of it. they are classified as manufacturing establishments.

- (2) Those primarily engaged in the production or processing of retail goods for direct trade with consumers are not classified as manufacturing establishments.
- (3) Those engaged in transferring their own basic materials to subcontracted factories in order to manufacture new products and sell the products under their own name are not classified as manufacturing establishments.

Establishments related to Service Industries

(1) Those primarily engaged in repair activities are not classified as manufacturing establishments. However, if the establishments are producing repair materials on the same premises as repairs are being carried out, they are classified as manufacturing establishments. If the establishments are engaged in repairing ships, the repair

and remodeling of railroad cars (other than railroad companies or local transit companies repairing and remodeling their own railroad cars), or overhauling airc raft, they are c

lassified as manufacturing establishments even if they have not performed any manufacturing activities during the previous year.

If the establishments are engaged in repairing a variety of machines and machine parts by producing parts and accessories for machinery at the machine repairing factories, using metal processing and metal working machinery, they are classified as manuf

acturing establishments. Because these kinds of repair activities are difficult to perform at establishments without any manufacturing facilities, and they are therefore classified as manufacturing establishments in special cases.

(2) Those engaged in fee based processing activities, using materials transferred from other establishments, and process them by fee based contract are classified as manufacturing establishments. However, those engaged in fee based processing to consumers'

individual order are not classified as manufacturing establishments.

- (3) Those primarily engaged in publishing activities are classified as manufacturing establishments even though they do not perform printing activities by thems elves.
- (4) Slaughterers are classified in division L (Services). However, establishments which slaughter animals as a part of their comprehensive meat production processes are classified as manufacturing establishments.

 G WHOLESALE AND RETAIL TRADE

This division includes establishments or places of business primarily engaged in buying and selling of merchandise. Those establishments engaged in wholesa le and retail trade, providing simple processing, installations, and repairs, in cidental to sell

ing, are also classified in this division.

Wholesale Trade is defined as the following activities:

- (1) Selling of merchandise to retailers or other wholesalers.
- (2) Selling of commodities in bulk to mines, plants, transportation services, ho tels, hospitals, schools, government agencies, and other industrial customers.
- (3) Selling of commodities for business use such as office machines and supplies industrial machinery other than agricultural machinery, equipment for restaurants and hotels, and construction materials including timber, cement and roofing tiles. Such comm
- odities are mostly supplied to industry and offices, but those, which are sold in exceptional cases to general consumers, are classified in the wholesale trade.
- (4) Selling of products manufactured or exploited by the same manufacturers or mining companies operating on separate premises (except in cases where there is integrated management).
- (5) Agents and brokers of selling and buying goods for other persons or companies, including those who mediate between sellers and buyers

Whole trade establishments, in principle, are classified based on the major commodities sold. The following business status are included in this division:

- (1) General Wholesale Trade: Included are wholesalers. bulk order distributors for industries, trading companies primarily engaged in wholesale trade, wholesale buyers (of textiles), exchange brokers, cargo collectors, sales offices of manufacturers and mi
- ning companies. and import export trading companies.
- (2) Manufacturing Wholesalers: those engaged in transferring their own materials to sub-contracted factories in order to manufacture new products and sell the products under their own name.
- (3) Agents. Brokers and Commission Merchants

Wholesale trade establishments classified in Major Groups 40 and 41 are primarily engaged in the buying and selling of commodities.

Agents and brokers classified in Major Group 41 are primarily engaged in brokerage or mediate between sellers and buyers, on a contract or fee bases. They

usually do not own the commodities, nor do they apprise, deposit or transport th

Note: The phrase "wholesalers manufacturing on the premises", generally used as the antonym of retailers manufacturing on the premises", means that the wholesalers are engaged in manufacturing activities. That is a completely different status from the "ma

nufacturing wholesaler

Retail Trade is defined as follows:

- (1) Selling of goods to consumers for personal or household use
- (2) Selling of commodities to industrial or business user, in small pieces. For the selling of commodities for business use, please refer to item (3) of the definition of wholesale trade.

Retail trade establishments are classified based either on the kinds of mer chandise sold or by the conventional classification of store names, such as habe rdashery stores, notion stores, and sundry stores. Bases for the classification of retail trade

are as follows:

(1) Those selling and repairing the same kind of products are classified in Major Group 82 (Automotive Repair, Services, and Parking) or 83 (Miscellaneous Repair Services) of Division L (Services). In such cases, it is not considered as a sales activity e

ven if parts are changed for repair purposes.

- (2) Retailers who manufacture on the premises, and sell their products directly to consumers, are classified not in wholesale but in retail trade.
- (3) Gasoline service stations are classified in retail trade.
- (4) Eating and drinking houses engaged in the retail trade of prepared food and drinks for on-premise consumption such as restaurants and fast-food stores are classified in retail trade.
- (5) Paddlers and open air stall keepers usually do not hold fixed or permanent places of business, but are classified in retail trade reflecting their activitie
- (6) Stands and inhouse stores operated within government, company, factory or the eater buildings, or in amusement parks by establishments different from the owner of the premises are separately classified as retail trade establishments.

 H FINANCE AND INSURANCE

This division includes establishments operating primarily in the fields of finance (banks, trust businesses, security businesses), insurance (insurance carriers, agents, and brokers), and related services. Establishments operating public financial and

insurance businesses such as postal savings and postal life insurance, cooperative associations primarily operating financial and insurance businesses are also included in this division. Agricultural mutual aid societies, federations of agricultural mutua

l aid societies, and agricultural mutual benefit funds which operate agricultural disaster insurances, as well as fishing boat insurance associations operating fishing boat disaster insurances are also classified in this division.

I REAL ESTATE

This division includes buyers, sellers, lessors and operators of real estate, as well as brokers and agents of buying, selling and exchanging real estate. Telephone subscription right brokers are also included in this division.

Real estate is defined as land, buildings, and other objects fixed to the l

Lessors of motion picture theaters, legitimate theaters, and athletic field s are classified in Industry Group 792 (Motion Picture Theaters). 801 (Legitimate Theaters and Performance Halls), and 805 (Athletic Fields) respectively, of Division L (Services).

Lessors of facilities for lecture meetings, exhibition halls, and other meetings and events are classified in Industry Group 951 (Meeting Halls) of Division L (Services).

Establishments primarily engaged in the preparation of land and building work, for lease, rent or resale using their own laborers, as well as in the constr

uction of ready-build houses by themselves are classified in Industry Group 161 (Civic Engineeri

ng and Building Construction), 162 (Heavy Construction), or 164 (Wooden Building Construction) of Division E (Construction).

Real estate apprising services are classified in Industry Group 879-9 (Miscellaneous Professional Services) of Division L (Services). I TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNICATIONS

This division includes establishments providing passenger and freight transport by rail, road, sea, and air, and services incidental to transportation, as well as those engaged in warehousing, communications, and services incidental to communications.

Many of the activities of establishments classified in this division are characterized to serve in the interest of the public. therefore, their services and compensations are extensively under legislative regulations.

K UTILITY SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY, GAS. WATER, AND HEAT

This division includes establishments primarily engaged in providing services for individuals, business establishments, and other organizations. Establishments primarily engaged in providing a variety of services: lodging (hotels, boarding houses, an

d rental of rooms), personal services, business services, repairs, amusement and recreation, medical and health care services, educational services, religious services, professional services, and non-profit organizations.

Establishments primarily engaged in providing agricultural services incidental to livestock farming (except veterinary services). sericulture, and cultivation, for agricultural establishments, as well as those providing horticultural services such as

weeding of garden plants are classified in Major Group 05 (Agricultural Services) of Division A (Agriculture).

Establishments primarily engaged in providing services incidental to forest ry, such as weeding and pruning of woods, are classified in Industry Group 064 (Forestry Services) of Division B (Forestry and Hunting).

Establishments primarily engaged in prospecting mines including geological surveys of mine sites, geophysical exploration of mines, and experimental drilling of mines, as well as in development of mines such as opening, boring, and removal of debris a

re classified in Division D (Mining).

Establishments primarily engaged in both the manufacture of new products and the repair of the same kind of products are classified in Division F (Manufacturing). Establishments primarily engaged in the repair of products, including those manufacturin

g materials used for repairing activities in the same establishments. are classified in this division.

Establishments primarily engaged in fee based processing activities. using materials transferred from other establishments, and processing them by fee based contract are classified in Division F (Manufacturing). However, those who are engaged in fee b

ased processing to individual order from household consumers, including those in volved in agriculture, forestry, and fishery, and who also use materials transferred from the orderers, are classified in this division.

Establishments primarily engaged in installations or repairs incidental to selling of products are not classified in this division. Those engaged in selling and repairing the same products are classified in Division C (Wholesale and Retail Trade).

Insurance carriers and services are classified in Division H (Finance and Insurance).

Establishments primarily engaged in the operation and brokerage of real est ate are classified in Division I (Real Estate).

Establishments primarily engaged in providing transportation facilities and services incidental to transportation are classified in Division J (Transportation and Communications).

M PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

N NONCLASSIFIABLE ESTABLISHMENTS

01 AGRICULTURE (EXCEPT AGRICULTURAL SERVICES)

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in agricultural production, livestock feeding (including poultry), sericulture, and bee keeping. O5 AGRICULTURAL SERVICES

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in performing agriculture related specialized services for agricultural establishments, as well as in landscaping, tree planting, and gardening services for others, on a contract or fee basis.

Establishments primarily engaged in milling or grinding grains, or repairing agricultural machines for agricultural establishments on a contract or fee bas is are included in Division L (Services).

- 06 FORESTRY
- 07 HUNTING
- 08 FISHING
- 09 AQUACULTURE
- 10 METAL MINING

Establishments primarily engaged in the mining, screening and refining of metal ores are classified in this major group. Establishments engaged in mining complex multi-metallic ores are classified based on the major metallic products to be extracted.

11 COAL MINING

Establishments engaged in drilling of underground driftways, opencast mining and other preparatory work for coal mining are also classified in this major group.

- 12 CRUDE PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS PRODUCTION
- 13 NON-METALLIC MINERALS MINING

Establishments primarily engaged in mining and quarrying of non-metallic minerals other than coal. lignite, crude petroleum, natural gas and asphalt rock, and in the screening and refining of non-metallic ores are classified in this major group.

15 SPECIAL TRADE CONTRACTORS

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in performing a part of the total construction of buildings or structures mainly for general contractors under subcontract. However, establishments primarily engaged in the installation of equ

ipment are classified in major group 17 (Equipment Installation Work).

16 GENERAL CONTRACTORS

This major group includes construction establishments mainly undertaking an entire project of building construction or civil engineering, or both, and work directly for property owners or for themselves.

17 EQUIPMENT INSTALLATION WORK--CONTRACTORS

This major group includes establishments mainly undertaking the installation of electrical equipment, communications and signal equipment, air—conditioning equipment, plumbing equipment, sanitary equipment, lift equipment, or other mechanical equipmen

- t, and mainly working directly for property owners or for general contractors under subcontract.
- 19 MANUFACTURING OF PISTOLS
- 20 MANUFACTURING OF FOOD

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in the manufacture of various kinds of food, animal and vegetable oil, man-made ice, organic fertilizers, and feeds for livestock and poultry.

Establishments which sell their food products directly to consumers, or carry out some simple treatment directly related to selling, are classified in Division G (Wholesale and Retail Trade)

- 21 MANUFACTURING OF TOBACCO
- 22 MANUFACTURING OF TEXTILE MILL PRODUCTS

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in the following manufacturing activities:

- (1) Silk spinning mills, production of spun yarns, and nets.
- (2) Production of woven fabrics. lace fabrics. braided cords. and cordage.

- (3) Refining, bleaching, dyeing, and finishing of yarns, threads, twists, woven fabrics, knit fabrics, and unwoven fabrics.
- (4) Production of cotton and felts.
- (5) Production of semimanufactured fabrics Including hemp and wool.

Establishments primarily engaged in the production of clothes and other textile products are classified in Major Group 23 (Manufacturing of Apparel and Other Finished Products Made from Fabrics and Similar Materials). Those primarily engaged in manufa

cturing chemical fabrics are classified in Industry Group 283 (Chemical Fibers) of Major Group 28 (Manufacturing of Chemical and Allied Products).

Establishments primarily engaged in the production of glass wool, rock wool, and asbestos are classified in Industry Group 321-5 (Glass Fiber and Its Products) and 329-1 (Asbestos and Rock Wool Products) of Major Group 32 (Manufacturing of Ceramic, Gl

ass. and Stone Products) respectively.

23 MANUFACTURING OF APPAREL. AND OTHER FINISHED PRODUCTS MADE FROM FABRICS AND SIMILAR MATERIALS

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing of apparel and other finished products made from purchased fabrics felts, and laces with cutting and needlework.

Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing knit undergarments are classified in Industry Group 234 (Manufacturing of Shirts and Undergarments) of this major group. However, those engaged in all other knit products are classified in Industry Gro

up 225 (Knitting Mills) of major group 22 (Manufacturing of Textile Mill Products).

A custom tailor or a dress shop where clothes and other apparel are made to order is classified in Major Group 44 (Retail Trade of Dry Goods. Apparel, and Accessories) if made from materials prepared by the same establishment, but it is classified in

Industry Group 782 (Garment Sewing and Repair Services) of Division L (Services) if made from materials brought in by customers.

24 MANUFACTURING OF LUMBER AND WOOD PRODUCTS. EXCEPT FURNITURE

Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing furniture and fixtures are classified in Major Group 25 (Manufacturing of Furniture and Fixtures). but those engaged in manufacturing cork products, wooden musical instruments, wooden toys, wooden spor

ting goods, and brooms are classified in Major Group 39 (Miscellaneous Manufacturing Industries).

Establishments primarily engaged in wood sawing at the site of construction as a part of construction operation, or engaged in the repair and reconditioning of buildings using wood, are classified in Major Group 15 (Special Trade Contractors), 16 (Gen

eral Contractors). or 17 (Equipment Installation Work) of Division E (Construction). Those primarily engaged in the production and sale of wooden products made to order are classified in Major Group 48 (Retail Trade of Furniture. Fixtures. and Household Ut

ensils) of Division G (Wholesale and Retail Trade).

25 MANUFACTURING OF FURNITURE AND FIXTURES

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing furniture used in dwellings and offices for religious purposes (including Japan ese and Western style), furniture and articles, doors, shoji screens, and sliding partitions.

Establishments primarily engaged in lacquer furniture are classified in Industry Group 397 (Japan Ware) of Major Group 39 (Miscellaneous Manufacturing Industries). Establishments engaged in manufacturing furniture and fixtures to order are classified

in industry group 481-1 (Furniture. Fixtures. and Rugs: Manufactured on the Premises) Stores of Division G (Wholesale and Retail Trade). Those primarily engaged in the reconditioning and repair of furniture are classified in Industry Group 832 (Reupholster

y and Furniture Repair) of Division L (Services).

26 MANUFACTURING OF PULP. PAPER AND ALLIED PRODUCTS

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in the manufacture of paper from wood, plant or other used cellulose fibers, as well as those manufacturing paper and converted paper products from paper materials. Although establishments pri

marily engaged in manufacturing paper yarn strings are classified in this major group. those manufacturing paper yarn fabrics are classified in Industry Group 2 23-9 (Miscellaneous Woven Fabric Mills) of Major Group 22 (Manufacturing of Textile Mill Product

s).

While establishments primarily engaged in the production of cellophane and fiberboard are classified in this industry, those manufacturing abrasive paper a re classified in Industry Group 326 (Abrasive Products) of Major Group 32 (Manufacturing of Cera

mic. Glass, and Stone Products) and manufacturing of photosensitive paper are classified in Industry Group 289-2 (Photosensitive Materials) of Major Group 28 (Manufacturing of Chemical and Allied Products)

27 PUBLISHING. PRINTING AND ALLIED INDUSTRIES--MANUFACTURING

28 MANUFACTURING OF CHEMICAL AND ALLIED PRODUCTS

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing products through predominantly chemical processes including chemical reaction. distillation, and decomposition, and establishments engaged in the mixing, synthesis, and finish

ing of chemical substances, not classified in any other major group.

The following should be noted:

- (1) Establishments primarily engaged in refining of nonferrous metals or manufacturing of alloy, while producing inorganic salt as by-products are classified in Major Group 33 (Manufacturing of Iron. Steel. and Nonferrous Metals).
- (2) Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing coke or refining petroleum, while producing coal tar as by-products are classified in Major Group 29 (Manufacturing of Petroleum and Coal Products).
- (3) Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing alcoholic beverages, manufacturing confectionery products made from gelatin, and manufacturing of vegetable and animal oil products are classified in Industry Group 208-1 (Alcoholic Beverages), 207 (Bak
- ery and Confectionery Products), and 209-1 (Vegetable and Animal Oil Mills) respectively, of Major Group 20 (Manufacturing of Food).
- (4) Establishments primarily engaged in the distillation of brimstone are classified in Industry Group 136 (Chemical and Fertilizer Minerals) of Division D (Mining)
- (5) Establishments primarily engaged in the packaging and repackaging of chemical products without manufacturing any chemical products are classified in Division G (Wholesale and Retail Trade).
- (6) Establishments primarily engaged in roasting lime and dolomite are classified in Major Group 32 (Manufacturing of Ceramics, Glass, and Stone Products).

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in refining petroleum, manufacturing asphalt paving materials, the production of coke, semi-coke, petroleum products and other petroleum refinery byproducts, as well as reclamation of waste of

- 1. Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing briquettes. briquette balls and other products from coal are also classified in this major group. However, establishments engaged in the distribution of utility gas produced by themselves are classified
- in Industry Group 711 (Gas Destribution) of Division L (Services). $30\ MANUFACTURING\ OF\ RUBBER\ PRODUCTS$

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in the manufacture of rubber products (tires. shoes, industrial rubber products, rubberized fabrics and other miscellaneous rubber products) made from natural rubber, synthetic rubber, gutta p

ercha, rubber powder, and gutta siak, as well as reclaimed rubber products and reconditioned tires. Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing rubberized

fabrics products using rubberized fabrics made in the same establishment are classified in this

major group.

Establishments engaged in manufacturing elastic fabrics are classified in I ndustry Group 224-2 (Narrow Fabrics and Other Textile Mills) of Major Group 22 (Manufacturing of Textile Mill Products), those manufacturing rubberized fabrics products using P

urchased rubberized fabrics are classified in Major Group 23 (Manufacturing of A pparel and Other Finished Products Made from Fabrics and Similar Materials). and establishments engaged in the production of synthetic rubber are classified in Industry Group 2

82-7 (Synthetic Rubber) of Major Group 28 (Manufacturing of Chemical and Allied Products).

31 MANUFACTURING OF LEATHER AND ALLIED PRODUCTS

Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing leather and synthetic le ather products, and fur products are classified in this major group. Establishments engaged in manufacturing luggage and bags are classified in this major group regardless of m

aterials. Those manufacturing fur clothes and leather clothes are classified in Industry Group 237 (Fur Goods) and 238 (Miscellaneous Apparel and Other Textile Products) respectively of Major Group 23 (Manufacturing of Apparel and Other Finished Products M

ade from Fabrics and Similar Materials). Establishments engaged in manufacturing sports goods and toys are classified in Industry Group 393 (Toys and Sports Goods) of Major Group 39 (Miscellaneous Manufacturing Industries).

32 MANUFACTURING OF CERAMIC. GLASS. AND STONE PRODUCTS

Establishments primarily engaged in the manufacture of glass products, ceme nt products, constructional clay, pottery and porcelain, carbon and graphite products, abrasive products, aggregate and stone products, lime products, and asbestos products fro

m non-metallic minerals are classified in this major group. Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing porcelain or enameled from ware are also classified in this major group.

33 MANUFACTURING OF IRON. STEEL. AND NONFERROUS METALS

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing iron and steel from iron ore and iron scrap, hot rolling, casting, and the manufacture of iron and steel, the cold finished steel and coated steel. Establishments primarily en

gaged in the smelting and refining of nonferrous metals from nonferrous ore, and scrap, the drawing and rolling of nonferrous metals, and the manufacture of nonferrous alloys, casting and forging of nonferrous metals, as well as the manufacture of miscella

neous nonferrous primary products are classified in this major group. Those enga ged in manufacturing electric wire and cable are also classified in this major g

34 MANUFACTURING OF FABRICATED METAL PRODUCTS

This major group includes establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing iron products and nonferrous metal products including tin cans and other plated sheet metal products, cutlery, handtools, general hardware, heating equipment other than electr

ical, constructional and architectural metal products, wire products and miscell aneous metal products not elsewhere classified. However, those establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing the following metal products are classified in other major groups.

(1) Machinery is classified in Major Group 35 (Manufacturing of Machinery. Except Electrical Machinery).

(2) Electrical machinery is classified in Major Group 36 (Manufacturing of Electrical Machinery and Equipment).

(3) Transportation equipment is classified in Major Group 37 (Manufacturing of T ransportation Equipment).

(4) Measuring scales, measuring instruments, surveying instruments, medical mach
